



Environmental Monitor

Madrone Environmental Services Ltd. (Madrone) and the Yale First Nation are looking for an environmental monitor to assist in the Giant Nickel Environmental monitoring program.

The monitoring program will take place at the closed Barrick Giant Nickel mine site, one day per month and 2 days per quarter during 2021.

The Environmental Monitor will assist the project biologist during the site visit. The Environmental Monitoring Program includes water sampling, sediment sampling, readouts from piezometers and dam inspection.

Travel to the mine site will be provided by Madrone and may include travel by truck, quad, side-by-side, snowmobile, or helicopter. Madrone will provide a Health & Safety Plan, and all participants are required to follow the Health & Safety protocols, including those for COVID-19.

While previous experience is appreciated, no direct experience in water sampling or environmental fieldwork is necessary. The project biologist will instruct all aspects of the job.
